Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue any appropriate Writ, order or direction more in the nature of Writ of Mandamus declaring the order passed by the 1st respondent dated 18.12.2009 disposing the Revision Petition i.e., Case No.D4/1162/09 filed by the 4th Respondent under Section 9 of A.P. Record of Rights in Land and Pattedar Pass Books Act 1971 at the admission stage setting aside the orders passed by the 2nd Respondent vide Procs. No.G/1521/2006 dated 24.10.2009 and also

directing the 2nd respondent to entertain the Cross appeal filed by the 4th Respondent, without any notice, without providing an opportunity to respondents in the revision and without assigning any valid reasons as nothing but arbitrary, illegal and violative of principles of natural justice and also contrary to the procedure contemplated under Section 9 of A.P. Records of Right in Land and Pattedar Pass Books Act 1971 (herein after referred to as the "ROR Act").

ORDER:

This writ petition is filed questioning the order passed by respondent No.1 in Case No.D4/1162/2009 dated 18.12.2009 under Section 9 of A.P. Record of Rights in land and Pattedar Pass Books Act, 1971.

2. After perusal of the records, it reveals that the writ petition is dismissed against the contesting respondent No.4 for non-compliance of the conditional order dated 30.04.2013 and by virtue of the dismissal of the writ petition against contesting respondent, the petitioner is not entitled to seek any relief in the writ petition.

3. Accordingly, the writ petition is dismissed. No costs.

As a sequel, miscellaneous petitions, pending if any, shall stand closed.
