Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a writ, order or direction more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus declaring the action of the Respondents in obtaining undertaking from the Respondent No.7, in respect of the Agricultural land to an extent of Ac.0-20 guntas, of Sy.No. 62, of Medipally Village of the Petitioner for the purpose of Medipally HMDA layout, allotting the farmers share house Plot Nos. 105 to 107, 113 to 115 (1800 Sq. Yards) to her along with alienable rights by

virtue of Proc. RC No. B/ 153/2022, dated 22.08.2023, without considering the objections of the petitioner is arbitrary and illegal.

IA NO: 1 OF 2023

Petition under Section 151 CPC praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to suspend the allotment proceedings RC No. B/ 153/2022, dated 22.08.2023 of farmers share house plot Nos. 105 to 107, 113 to 115 (1800 Sq. Yards) including directing the Respondents No.6, not to entertain any sort of registrations, creating 3rd party rights in respect of the above plots in Sy.No. 62 of Medipally Village and Mandal, pending disposal of the writ petition.

IA NO: 2 OF 2023

Petition under Section 151 CPC praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the respondents not to interfere / dispossess the petitioner from his agricultural land to an extent of Ac. 0-20 guntas, in Sy.No. 62 of Medipally Village and Mandal, pending disposal of the writ petition in the interest of justice.

As a sequel thereto, miscellaneous petitions, if any, pending in this writ petition stand closed.

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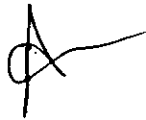

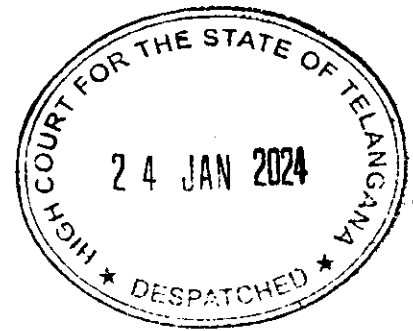
