Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue an appropriate writ or direction more particularly one in the nature of writ of mandamus directing the respondents to pay the admitted bills amount in respect of the works executed by the petitioner i.e., for execution of the work i.e. BT to R/F Matkepally to Tirlapuram of Chinthakani Mandal, Khammam District under special development fund scheme with interest or 9% p.a. without reference to the Memo.No.13/Pig.IX/SDF/2014, Dt-25-06-2014 of the 4th respondent by further declaring the entire action of the respondents in not making payments of the admitted bills amount in respect of the works executed by the petitioner, while making payments in respect of other similarly situated contractors as highly illegal, arbitrary, unjust, improper, discriminatory, violative of all principles of natural justice

I.A. NO: 1 OF 2015(WVMP. NO: 4539 OF 2015)

Petition under Section 151 CPC praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to vacate the interim orders dt. 04-11-2015 passed in WPMP.No.43670/2015 in WP.No.33896/2015 and dismiss the WP and permit the Government and Department to act as per rules and procedure issued by the Government Tentatively and as per terms and conditions of agreement the payment will be made to the executants.

Petition under Section 151 CPC praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the respondents to forthwith pay the admitted bills amount in respect of the works executed by the petitioner i.e., i.e. " BT to R/F" Matkepally to Tirlapuram of Chinthakani Mandal; Khammam District" under special development fund scheme for the year 2013-14, if necessary without reference to Govt. Memo No.13/Plg.IX/SDF/2014, dated 25.6.2014

WRIT PETITION No.33896 of 2015

ORDER:

The case of the petitioner is that he is a contractor who executed the work of laying roads assigned by the 2nd respondent/the Superintending Engineer, Panchayat Raj Circle, Khammam. The petitioner's grievance is that the authorities have not cleared the pending bills related to the work for the 'BT to RF' road from Matkepally to Tirlapuram in Chinthakani Mandal, Khammam District.

2. This Court, on 04.11.2015 while admitting the writ petition, granted the following interim order in W.P.M.P.No.43670 of 2015:

'Pending disposal of the writ petition, as the petitioner claims that the amounts due are under admitted bills, there shall be a direction to the respondent authorities to verify and quantify the amounts due to the petitioner in terms of the works admittedly executed and such undisputed amounts, if any, shall be paid to the petitioner within four weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of the order.'

3. Today at the hearing, Sri Aravind Kumar Kata, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the admitted bills have been paid by the respondent-authorities and therefore the writ petition may be closed.

4. Recording the submissions made, this writ petition is closed. No costs.

Miscellaneous applications, pending if any, shall stand closed.
