This Criminal Petition is filed by the petitioner/accused seeking to quash the proceedings against him in S.C.No.31 of 2023 on the file of the learned Principal Senior Civil Judge-cum-Assistant Sessions Judge, Mahabubnagar (for short, "the trial Court").

2. No representation on behalf of the petitioner. Heard Mr.Jithender Rao Veeramalla, learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing for respondent No.1-State.

3. Learned Additional Public Prosecutor, by filing the copy of letter dated 21.10.2024 addressed by the Sub-Inspector of Police, Koilkonda Police Station, Mahabubnagar District, would submit that S.C.No.31 of 2023 has ended up in acquittal vide judgment dated 20.02.2024. Therefore, he would submit that no further orders are required in this Criminal Petition and seeks to dismiss this Criminal Petition as infructuous.

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4. Recording the submissions of the learned Additional Public Prosecutor and taking the copy of letter dated 21.10.2024 onto the file, this Criminal Petition is dismissed as infructuous.
