2. Learned counsel for the petitioners restricted his prayer to the extent of dispensing with the presence of the petitioners before the trial Court.

3. Hence, if there are no warrants pending against the petitioners, the appearance of the petitioners before the trial Court is dispensed with unless their presence is specifically required during the course of trial, subject to the condition of petitioner being represented by their counsel on every date of hearing.

4. Accordingly, the Criminal Petition is disposed of. Pending miscellaneous petitions, if any, in this Criminal Petition shall also stand closed.
