Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue an appropriate writ or order or direction more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus declaring the orders of the 1st respondent in issuing G.O.Ms.No. 3, dt. 14.08.2014 and G.O.Ms.No. 16, dt. 11.03.2015 in deleting the "Setti Baija" community / caste from the list of Backward Class Community in State of Telangana without recommendation of Backward Class Commission of Telangana as illegal, arbitrary and set aside the same and consequently direct the respondents No.1 and 2 to issue Caste Certificate to the petitioners daughter namely BONTHU DEVISREE under BC "B" category (Setti Baija community / caste)

ORDER:

Heard Sri Ponakampalli Ravi Kumar, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner, learned Assistant Government Pleader for Social Welfare, appearing on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 5 and learned Additional Advocate General, appearing on behalf of respondent No.6.

2. The petitioner approached the Court seeking prayer as under:

" to issue an appropriate writ or order or direction more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus declaring the orders of the 1st respondent in issuing G.O. Ms. No. 3 dated 14.08.2014 and G.O. Ms. No. 16 dated 11.03.2015 in deleting the "Setti Balija" community/caste from the list of Backward Class Community in State of Telangana without recommendation of Backward Class Commission of Telangana as illegal, arbitrary and set aside the same and consequently direct the respondents No.1 and 2 to issue Caste Certificate to the petitioner's daughter namely BONTHU DEVISREE under BC "B" category (Setti Balija community / caste) and pass ...".

3. It is represented by learned Assistant Government Pleader appearing on behalf of respondents that in view of the Judgment dated 04.09.2015 passed by the Division Bench of this Court in W.P. Nos. 13454, 14459, 14665, 14950 of 2015 and batch the cause of action in the present writ petition does not survive for adjudication any more.

4. **Bringing the said submission on record, the Writ Petition is dismissed as infructuous. However, there shall be no order as to costs.**

5. **The interim order granted by this Court on 03.08.2015 in W.P.M.P. No. 31384 of 2015 stands vacated.**

As a sequel, the miscellaneous petitions, if any, pending in the Writ Petition shall also stand closed.
