THE HONOURABLE SRI JUSTICE K.SURENDER**CRIMINAL PETITION NO.7719 OF 2019****ORDER :**

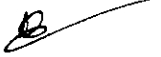
This Criminal Petition under Section 482 of the Cr.P.C is filed by the petitioners – Accused Nos.1 & 2 to quash the proceedings initiated against them in C.C.No.33 of 2018 on the file of learned Judicial First Class Magistrate, Kodangal. The offences alleged against the petitioners are punishable under Sections 341, 354(A)(D) and 504 of IPC.

2. None appears for the petitioners. Perused the record.
3. The crime is of the year 2017. As seen from the proceeding sheet, no interim orders were passed by this Court when the case was filed earlier. The stage in the trial Court is not known, this Court is not inclined to keep this Criminal Petition pending.
4. Accordingly, this Criminal Petition is disposed off. However, the petitioners are at liberty to approach this Court under Section 482 of Cr.P.C, in case any cause survives.

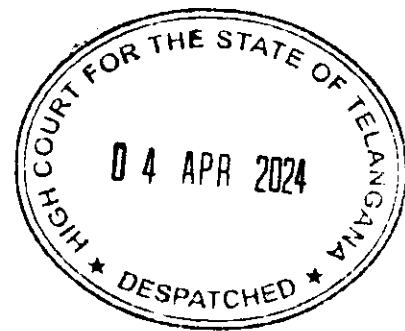
