Petition Under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to pass an order or direction or writ in the nature of Mandamus duly declaring the inaction of the respondents in not considering the online application vide NO No76BPLBDD220811007210 dated- 11/08/2022 under GO 76 of 2019 seeking regularization of residential house in a plot admeasuring about 270 square yards of land, Sy. No. 143, R/o. H.NO. 12-1-52/2, Burma Camp, Kothagudem, BhadradiKothagudem District, as illegal, arbitrary and against the principles of natural justice and consequently, direct the respondents to consider

the above application and grant the Patta for the above property in the interest of justice.

ORDER (ORAL):

Heard Sri P.Rama Sharana Sharma, learned counsel for petitioner, Sri H.Somaiah, learned Assistant Government Pleader for Assignment appearing on behalf of respondent Nos.1, 2, 4 and 5 and Sri P. Sri Harsha Reddy, learned Standing Counsel for Singareni Collieries Co. Ltd., appearing for respondent No.3. Perused the record.

02. Petitioner is claiming that she is in occupation of the House bearing No.12-1-52/2, Burma Camp, Kothagudem Village and Mandal, Bhadradri Kothagudem District to an extent of 270 Sq.yds. She submitted an Online Application in Dharani Portal vide No. 76BPLBDD220811007210 dated 11.08.2022 with respondent No.2 under G.O.Ms.No.76 dated 11.07.2019 seeking regularization of the said property. Despite receiving and acknowledging the said online application, respondent No.2 did not act upon the same. Aggrieved by

the said inaction of respondent No.2, petitioner has filed this Writ Petition.

03. Learned Government Pleader appearing for respondent Nos.1, 2, 4 and 5 would submit that the online application submitted by petitioner will be considered and appropriate orders will be passed in accordance with law.

04. Learned Standing Counsel for respondent No.3 seeks an opportunity to be given before considering online application of petitioner.

05. In the light of the aforesaid submissions, this Writ Petition is disposed of directing respondent No.2 to consider Online Application in Dharani Portal vide No. 76BPLBDD220811007210 dated 11.08.2022 submitted by petitioner claiming regularization of the said property under G.O.Ms.No.76 dated 11.07.2019 and pass appropriate orders, strictly in accordance with law by putting petitioner and respondent No.3 and all interested parties on notice and affording them an opportunity. If respondent No.2 is not inclined to consider the request of

petitioner, he shall pass a reasoned order and communicate a copy of such order to petitioner. Respondent No.2 shall complete the entire exercise within eight (08) weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this Order.

06. With the above directions, this Writ Petition is disposed of. There shall be no order as to costs.

As a sequel thereto, miscellaneous applications, if any, pending in this Writ Petition stand closed.

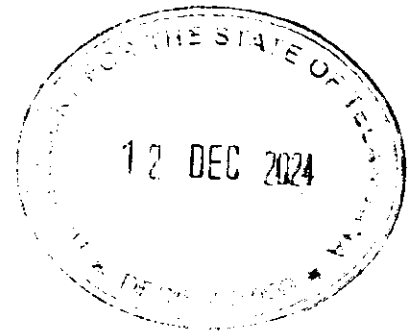
