This Petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the Memorandum of Grounds of Criminal Petition and upon hearing the arguments of Sri Syed Jaweed Abbas Nadeem, Advocate for the Petitioner and Sri M. Ramachandra Reddy, Additional Public Prosecutor on behalf of the Respondent.

The Court made the following: ORDER

to implicate him in the present case and there is no prima facie offence and the petitioner herein is innocent and was implicated in false case and hence, prayed to grant bail.

5. The learned Additional Public Prosecutor opposed the application stating that serious allegations are leveled against petitioner. He further submits that the investigation in the case is in progress and hence, prayed to dismiss the petition.

6. Having heard both sides and on perusal of the material, since serious allegations are levelled against the petitioner, as the investigation is still pending and charge sheet is not filed, this Court is of the considered view that it is not a fit case for grant of anticipatory bail. However, the petitioner/accused No.5 is at liberty to surrender before the Court concerned and file an application, in which event, such application may be considered preferably on the same day and pass appropriate orders on merits.

7. Accordingly, this criminal petition is dismissed.
