Petition Under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to pass an order or direction or writ in the nature of Mandamus duly declaring the inaction of the respondents herein in considering the online application vide No. 2200138487, dated 15.11.2022 as well as subsequent representations, the latest being dated 05.08.2024 seeking correction of entries in the Pattadar Pass Book in respect of property Ac. 2.00gts. in Sy.No. 28/2/1 situated at Lingala Village, Charla Mandal, BhadradriKothagudem District as illegal, arbitrary and against the principles of natural justice and consequently,

direct the respondent to consider the online application vide No. 2200138487, dated 15.11.2022 and rectify the above said entries in the interest of justice.

ORAL ORDER:

Heard Sri P. Rama Sharana Sharma, learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and Sri L. Ravinder, learned Assistant Government Pleader for Revenue appearing for respondent Nos.1 to 4. Perused the record.

2. In view of the nature of relief sought, this writ petition is disposed of dispensing with notice to respondent No.5.

3. Petitioner is claiming that he is the absolute owner and possessor of land admeasuring Ac.3-00 gts., in Sy.No.28/9, situated at Lingala Village, Cherla Mandal, Bhadradi Kothagudem District. He is also owner of land in other survey numbers in the very same village. In proof of the same, he has filed copies of latest pattedar pass book and title deed. In Dharani portal, Ac.2-00 gts., is mentioned in the name of respondent No.5. Therefore, there is wrong entry in Dharani portal. Therefore, he has

submitted online application bearing No.2200138487 dated 15.11.2022 with respondent No.2 with a request to correct the said wrong entry. Despite receiving and acknowledging the said online application, respondent No.2 did not act upon the same. Aggrieved by the inaction of respondent No.2, petitioner filed the present writ petition.

4. Whereas learned Assistant Government Pleader for Revenue, on instructions, would submit that respondent No.2 will consider the online application submitted by the petitioner and pass appropriate orders in accordance with law.

5. In the light of the aforesaid submission, this writ petition is disposed of, directing respondent No.2 to consider and dispose of the online application bearing No.2200138487 dated 15.11.2022 submitted by the petitioner and pass appropriate orders, in accordance with law by putting the petitioner, respondent No.5 and all affected parties on notice and affording them an

opportunity. If respondent No.2 is not inclined to accept the request made by the petitioner, he shall pass a reasoned order and communicate copy of the said order to the petitioner. He shall complete the entire exercise within a period of eight (8) weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. There shall be no order as to costs.

As a sequel, miscellaneous petitions, if any, pending in the Writ Petition shall stand closed.
