Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue writ or direction preferably Writ of Mandamus declaring the inaction of the 3rd respondent in considering my representations dt-20-11-2006 and latest being on 15-5-2015 for payment of compensation or Rs.8,000/- per sq for the acquired land of the petitioner to an extent of 484 sq.yards in Sy.NO.226/2A, Khanapuram Haveli, Khammam Town, Khammam Dist., nor referring the matter to competent civil court as illegal, arbitrary, violative of principles of natural justice and also violative of Art.300-A of Constitution of India and consequently direct the respondents to pay the enhanced compensation amount to the petitioner.

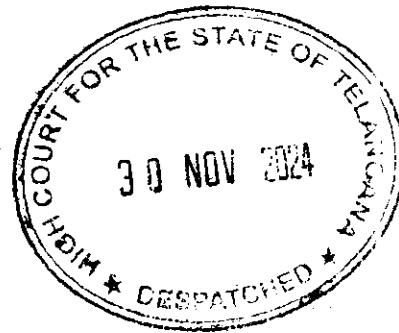
