ORDER:

This Criminal Petition is filed by the petitioner/accused seeking to quash the proceedings against him in C.C.No.14 of 2017 on the file of the learned Principal Junior Civil Judge, Kamareddy.

2. Heard Mr.Almas Begum Mohammed, learned counsel for the petitioner and Mr.Jithender Rao Veeramalla, learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing for respondent No.1-State. With the consent of both the learned counsel, this Criminal Petition is disposed of at the stage of admission.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner confined his prayer to dispense with the personal appearance of the petitioner.

4. Considering the submission of learned counsel for the petitioner, the appearance of the petitioner is dispensed with in C.C.No.14 of 2017 on the file of the learned Principal Junior Civil Judge, Kamareddy when represented by his counsel on record. The appearance of the petitioner is dispensed with subject to filing an affidavit by the petitioner stating that in his absence, the

proceedings conducted by his counsel will not be disputed by him in any manner and shall not dispute his identity also. However, the petitioner shall appear before the learned Magistrate as and when his presence is required. In the event of failure of the petitioner to appear when the Court directs, this order dispensing with his appearance shall stand cancelled.

5. Accordingly, the Criminal Petition is disposed of.
