ORDER :

This Criminal Petition is filed by the petitioner/accused under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. seeking to quash the proceedings in FIR No.210 of 2024, dated 21.09.2024 on the file of SHO, Wyra Police Station, Khammam District.

2. Heard Sri M.Janardhan Rao, learned counsel for the petitioner, Sri G.Bhanu Prasad, learned counsel for the 2nd respondent and Sri E.Ganesh, learned Assistant Public Prosecutor, representing learned Public Prosecutor for the 1st respondent/State.

During the course of proceedings, by producing letter dated 05.11.2024, addressed by him to the Registrar (Judicial), High Court for the State of Telangana, it is brought to the notice of this Court by the learned counsel for the petitioner that in view of information given by the police under RTI Act to the petitioner, the petitioner requested to withdraw the present criminal petition. Stating thus, he requested to dismiss the present criminal petition as withdrawn. Learned counsel for the 2nd respondent and learned Assistant Public Prosecutor have expressed no objection.

4. Recording the above submissions this criminal petition is dismissed as withdrawn. Miscellaneous applications, if any pending, shall also stand dismissed.
