circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be
pleased to issue a writ or order or direction, especially one in the nature of
mandamus (i) declare that the impugned memo No.CGM(HRD)/GM/(S)/AS.II/PO-
III/F.No.882/03, dated 30-1-2004 of the respondent herein as illegal, arbitrary and
without jurisdiction and set aside the same ii) to declare that Petitioner is entitled
for a) earned leave for 38 days from 19-8-2002 to 25-9-2002 b) Earned Leave for
66 days from 31-11-2002 to 7-1-2003. c) half-pay leave for 206 days from 31-1-
2003 to 6-8-2003 and for all the Constitutional benefits- iii) direct the respondent
to sanction me a) earned leave for 38 days from 19-8-2002 to 25-9-2002. b)
earned leave for 66 days from 31-11-2002 to 7-1-2003 c) Half-pay leave for 206
days from 31-1-2003 to 6-8-2003 and for all the consequential benefits.

WRIT PEITION No.15390 of 2005

ORDER:

This writ petition has been filed with a prayer for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus to declare the impugned Memo No.CGM(HRD)/GM/(S)/AS.II/P)-III/F.No.882/03, dated 30.01.2004 is illegal and to declare that he is entitled for earned leave for 38 days, 66 days, half pay leave for 206 days and consequential benefits and to direct the respondents to sanction earned leave and half pay leave with consequential benefits.

2. None appeared for the writ petitioner. Heard Mr. Zakir Ali Danish, learned counsel for the sole respondent is present.

3. A perusal of the proceeding sheet is indicating that on the demise of counsel for the writ petitioner notice has been ordered on the petitioner through Court and the same was properly served on 24.06.2024. However the petitioner did not choose either to appear or to engage counsel to prosecute the matter. This situation is implying that the petitioner has lost interest in conducting the writ petition.

4. In this view of the matter, the writ petition is dismissed for non prosecution. There shall be no order as to costs.

As a sequel, pending miscellaneous petitions if any, stands closed.

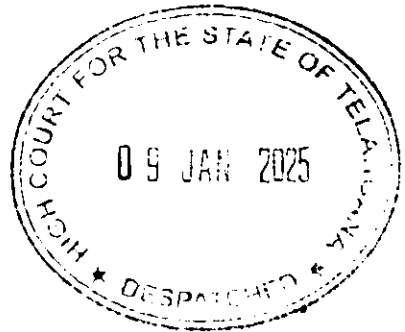
