Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a Writ, Order, or Direction, more particularly in the nature of Writ of Mandamus, declaring the inaction of the Respondent No.2 in failing to consider the representation dated 08/11/2024, 06/1/2024, seeking adequate security and protection for the Jashan-e-Wiladat Shahzadiye Kounain scheduled for December 22, 2024, as illegal, arbitrary, and violative of the Petitioner s fundamental rights under Articles 14, 19, 21, and 25 of the Constitution of India, and consequently direct the Respondents to provide adequate security and protection for the entire duration of the celebration, including pre-event preparation and post-event dispersal, by deploying sufficient personnel to maintain law and order, deter potential violence, and ensure the safety and security of all attendees.

Petition under Section 151 CPC praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct Respondent No.2 to consider the representation dated 08/11/2024, 06/1/2024, and to provide adequate security and protection for the "Jashar -e-Wiladat Shahzadiye Kounain" scheduled on December 22, 2024 including pre-event preparation and post-event dispersal, by deploying sufficient personnel to maintain law and order, deter potential violence, and ensure the safety and security of all attendees, pending disposal of the writ petition.
