Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a writ, order or direction more particularly one in the nature of WRIT OF MANDAMUS to declare the impugned Notice No.RG.I/PER/Q-Dismantled/63/6561, dated 07.12.2024 of the 1st respondent like-wise the same notices were issued on the names of the other petitioners in respect of the quarters situated at Hanuman Nagar and Shivaji Nagar Chowrastha / Shopping Complex Area, Godavarikhani, Peddapalli District and removed the power and water supply to the petitioners quarters respectively without waiting the report of the II Addl. Junior Civil Judge, Godavarikhani, Peddapalli District, as illegal, arbitrary, null, void and violation of Article 21 of the Constitution of India and violation of the orders of the Hon'ble High Court in W.P.No.18696 of 2024 and consequently to set aside the same and allow the petitioners to reside in their respective quarters as usual

Petition under Section 151 CPC praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the writ petition, the High Court may be pleased to suspend the impugned Notice No.RG.I/PER/Q-Dismantled/63/6561, dated 07.12.2024 of the 1st respondent by restoring the power and water supply to the petitioners quarters situated at Hanuman Nagar and Shivaji Nagar Chowrastha / Shopping Complex Area, Godavarikhani, Peddapalli District, pending finalization of the Writ Petition

The Court made the following: ORDER

HON'BLE MRS JUSTICE SUREPALLI NANDA

WRIT PETITION No.34812 OF 2024

ORDER:

Heard Sri Jalli Kanakaiah, learned Senior Designated Counsel representing Sri Narender Jalli, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners, learned Special Government Pleader Sri Rahul Reddy, representing the office of learned Additional Advocate General, appearing on behalf of respondent Nos.3 to 5 and Sri P. Sri Harsha Reddy, learned Standing Counsel appearing on behalf of respondent Nos.1 and 2.

2. The petitioners approached the Court seeking prayer as under:

" ...to issue a writ order or direction more particularly one in the nature of WRIT OF MANDAMUS to declare the impugned Notice No.RG. I/PER/Q-Dismantled/63/6561, dated 07-12-2024 of the 1st respondent likewise the same notices were issued on the names of the other petitioners in respect of the quarters situated at Hanuman Nagar and Shivaji Nagar Chowrastha / Shopping Complex Area, Godavarikhani Peddapalli District and removed the power and water supply to the petitioners quarters respectively without

waiting the report of the II Addl Junior Civil Judge Godavarikhani Peddapalli District as illegal, arbitrary, null void and violation of Article 21 of the Constitution of India and violation of the orders of the Honble High Court in W.P. No. 18696 of 2024 and consequently to set aside the same and allow the petitioners to reside in their respective quarters as usual and pass...".

3. It is represented by the learned Senior Counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners that, the petitioners are not insisting for grant of the prayer as sought for in the present writ petition but are only seeking prayer as granted in I.A. No.2 of 2024 in W.P. No. 18696 of 2024 and in W.P. No. 18696 of 2024 and further the learned Senior Counsel requested to extend the said benefit as extended to the petitioners in I.A. No.2 of 2024 in W.P. No. 18696 of 2024 and W.P. No. 18696 of 2024 to the petitioners herein. The relevant para Nos.4 and 5 of the order dated 14.08.2024 passed in I.A. No.2 of 2024 in W.P. No. 18696 of 2024 and in W.P. No. 18696 of 2024 are extracted hereunder:

"4. Taking into consideration the averments made in the affidavit filed in support of I.A.No.2 of 2024 in W.P.No.18696 of 2024, and duly considering the submissions of all the learned counsel on record, this Court opines that the learned II Additional Junior Civil Judge, Godhavarikhani, Peddapally District would be the Impartial Independent Authority to

accompany the petitioners in petitioners inspection and selection of 24 quarters out of 61 existing quarters, which are habitable quarters with all basic amenities and the petitioners are further directed to select their respective 24 quarters in the presence of the said learned II Additional Junior Civil Judge, Godhavarikhani, Peddapally District and occupy the same duly vacating the existing quarters which the petitioners are presently in occupation as per their choice on due inspection in the presence of the learned II Additional Junior Civil Judge, Godhavarikhani, Peddapally District as expeditiously as possible preferably within a period of fifteen(15) days from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

5. Accordingly, the I.A.No.2 of 2024 in W.P.No.18696 of 2024 and Writ Petition No.18696 of 2024 stands disposed off with the above observations. However, there shall be no order as to costs.

4. The learned Special Government Pleader appearing on behalf of the learned Additional Advocate General submits that the said benefit as extended to the petitioners in I.A. No.2 of 2024 in W.P. No. 18696 of 2024 and in W.P. No. 18696 of 2024 was also extended to the petitioners in the present writ petition but however the petitioners did not avail the same.

5. Taking into consideration the earlier orders of this Court dated 14.08.2024 passed in I.A.No.2 of 2024 in W.P.No.18696 of 2024 and in W.P.No.18696 of 2024 (referred to and extracted above) and duly considering the submissions of all the learned counsel on record, this Court opines that the respondents would allot the habitual quarters with basic amenities to the petitioners which had already been inspected by the learned II Additional Junior Civil Judge, Godhavarikhani, Peddapalli District within one (1) week from the date of receipt of a copy of the order.

6. Accordingly, the present writ petition is disposed of. However, there shall be no order as to costs.

As a sequel, the miscellaneous petitions, if any, pending in the Writ Petition shall also stand closed.

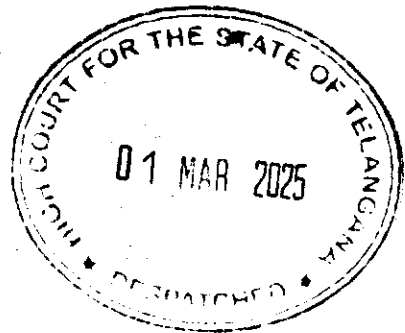
