Engineers and Addl, Asst. Engineers.

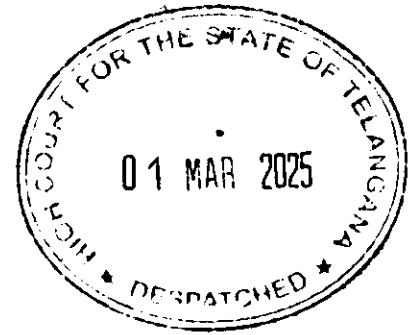
