This Petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the Memorandum of Grounds of Criminal Petition and upon hearing the arguments of Sri Saman Aafreen, Advocate for the Petitioner and Sri Veeramalla Jithender Rao, Additional Public Prosecutor on behalf of the Respondent No. 1.

The Court made the following Order :

ORDER:

The present Criminal Petition is filed under Section 528 Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita (for short 'BNSS') to quash the proceedings against the petitioner in C.C.No.216 of 2011 on the file of the learned XIII Additional Chief Metropolitan Magistrate, Hyderabad.

2. Heard Sri Saman Aafreen, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner as well as Sri Veeramalla Jithender Rao, learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing on behalf of the respondent -State.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner restricted his prayer and submitted that to direct the trial Court, to conclude the trial in C.C.No.216 of 2011 within a period of six (6) months or earlier and prayed the Court to pass appropriate orders.

4. Hence, considering the limited grievance of the petitioner and considering the fact that C.C.No.216 of 2011 pertains to the year 2011, the trial Court is directed to dispose of the same, as expeditiously as possible, preferably within a period

of six (06) months from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

5. Accordingly, the Criminal Petition is disposed of.

Miscellaneous applications, if any pending, shall also stand closed.

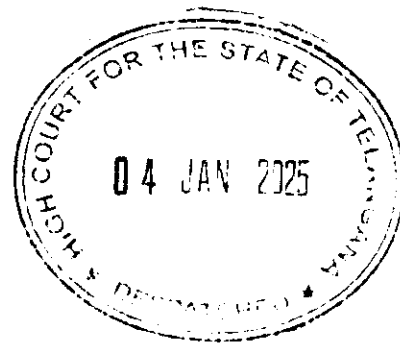
