Metropolitan Sessions Judge at Nampally pending disposal of the main petition.

I.A. NO: 3 OF 2024 IN CRL.P.NO.15840 OF 2024:

Petition under Section 320 (6) of Cr.P.C praying that in the circumstances stated in the Memorandum of Grounds of Criminal Petition, the High Court may be pleased to permit the petitioner and respondent No.2 who is the defacto-

complainant to compound the offence and to allow the above CrI.P, against charge sheet vide S.C.No.825 of 2023 on the file of the IV Addl. Metropolitan Sessions Judge at Nampally, for the offences U/Sec.302, 202 IPC.

I.A. NO: 4 OF 2024 IN CRL.P.NO.15840 OF 2024:

Petition under Section 482 of Cr.P.C & U/s.528 of BNS Act, 320 (2) of Cr.P.C praying that in the circumstances stated in the Memorandum of Grounds of Criminal Petition, the High Court may be pleased to record the compromise and compound the offence in S.C.No.825 of 2023 on the file of the IV Addl. Metropolitan Sessions Judge at Nampally, for the offences U/Sec.302, 202 IPC .

This Petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the Memorandum of Grounds of Criminal Petition and upon hearing the arguments of Sri RAPOLU BHASKAR, Advocate for the Petitioner and the Assistant Public Prosecutor on behalf of the Respondent No.1 and None Appeared for the Respondent No.2

ORAL ORDER:

This criminal petition is filed by the petitioner challenging the proceedings in SC.No.825 of 2023 pending on the file of the IV Additional Metropolitan Sessions Judge, at Nampally, seeking to quash proceedings against him.

2. Heard Sri Rapolu Bhaskar, learned counsel for petitioner, and learned Assistant Public Prosecutor for respondent No.1 – State. None appeared for respondent No.2.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that IA.Nos.3 and 4 of 2024 are filed praying to compound the offences as alleged and compromise the matter. However, the learned Assistant Public Prosecutor, intervened and submitted that the offences as alleged against the petitioner are non compoundable. As such, learned counsel for petitioner confined his prayer to the extent of issuing direction to

the trial Court to expedite the proceedings in pending SC.

4. Having regard to the submissions made, this Court directs the trial Court to dispose of SC.No.825 of 2023 as expeditiously as possible.

5. Accordingly, the Criminal Petition is disposed of.

Pending miscellaneous petitions, if any, in this Criminal Petition shall also stand closed.
