

THE HONOURABLE SMT. JUSTICE K. SUJANA

CRIMINAL PETITION No.15834 of 2024

ORDER:

Seeking the Court to enlarge the petitioner who is arrayed as accused in Crime No.234 of 2024 of Boothpur (Annasagar) Police Station, Mahabubnagar, on bail, the present Criminal Petition is filed.

2. The brief facts of the case are that on 27.10.2024, after loading goods from Amazon, warehouse at Embassy Industrial Park Farrukhnagar, Gurugram district, the driver of the container vehicle bearing No.NL 07 AA 1957, stop the said vehicle near Indian Oil Petrol Pump at NH 44 and some valuable electronic goods were stolen by cutting container from inside driver's cabin. Hence, a case was registered vide Crime No.234 of 2024 before the Boothpur (Annasagar) Police, Mahabubnagar, for the offences punishable under Section 303(2) of the BNS.

3. Heard Sri M.Prashanth Kumar, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner as well as Sri Syed Yasar Manoon, learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing on behalf of the respondent-State.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner *firstly* submitted that the petitioner is innocent and he is no way concerned with the alleged offences. He *secondly* submitted that though there is no corroborative evidence, the petitioner was implicated in the case with false and fabricated allegations. He *thirdly* submitted that all the material witnesses were examined, and further detention of the petitioner is unnecessary. He *fourthly* submitted that the petitioner has been in judicial custody since 11.11.2024, causing undue hardship to his family. He *lastly* submitted that the petitioner is resident of Ujina Mewat, Haryana, with movable and immovable properties, and is willing to furnish sureties as directed and prayed the Court to grant bail to the petitioner by allowing this criminal petition.

5. On the other hand, learned Additional Public Prosecutor opposed the submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioner stating that the investigation is not yet completed, therefore, granting bail to the petitioner, at this stage, does not arise. Hence, he prayed the Court to dismiss the criminal petition.

6. After considering submissions from both the parties and reviewing the record, since the petitioner is languishing in jail from 11.11.2024 without there being any criminal antecedents pending against him and also material part of investigation is

completed, this Court deems it fit to grant bail to the petitioner subject to the following conditions:

- i. The petitioner shall execute a personal bond for a sum of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand only) each, with two sureties for a like sum each to the satisfaction of the First Additional Judicial Magistrate, Jadcherla.
- ii. The petitioner shall appear before the concerned SHO at 11:00 a.m., on every Monday for a period of eight (8) week or till filing of charge sheet whichever is earlier, for the purpose of investigation, and thereafter, as and when required.
- iii. The petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated in Section 437(3) of Cr.P.C.(presently, Section 480(3) of the BNSS).

7. Accordingly, the Criminal petition is allowed.

Miscellaneous applications, if any pending, shall stand closed.
