Rukmabai as Ac. 4-23 gts., instead of Ac. 14-23 gts., in Sy>no. 171 after her transfer and conveyance of Ac. 10-00 gts., out of Ac. 14-23 gts., in

favour of G. Mallaiah through registered sale deed doc.No. 5531965 and its implementation in the revenue records as per the faisal patti of the year 1970-71 by the 4th respondent as itself as illegal, arbitrary, malafide and consequential directions that those entries would not in any way effect the rights, title interest and possession of the petitioners over owned and possessed their respective extents of land i.e., 1st petitioner to an extent of Ac. 4-20 gts., through registered sale deed bearing doc.NO. 17452/2005, dt. 14-11-2005 and the 2nd petitioner to an extent of 1Ac. 4-20 gts, through registered sale deed bearing doc.no. 17451/2005 in Wy.No. 171 of Kondakal Village, Shankerpally Mandal, Ranga Reddy District acquired through registered sale deeds
