**Writ Petition No.36761 of 2024**

**ORDER :** *(Per the Hon'ble Sri Justice Abhinand Kumar Shavili)*

This Writ Petition is filed by the petitioner under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking the following relief:

“...to issue a writ order or direction more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Habeas Corpus in non-producing the detenu or trace out the detenue by the 3rd and 4th respondents in pursuance of the Complaints dated 22.12.2024 and 23.12.2024 as an illegal ex-facie, arbitrary, discriminatory, unjust, unfair, whimsical, non-application of mind, unlawful, unconstitutional and in violation of Principles of Natural Justice and in violation of Article 14, 19 and 21 of the Constitution of India and also against the catena of judgments of this Hon'ble Court and an Apex Court and consequently direct the 3rd and 4th respondents to produce the detenu before this Hon'ble Court in pursuance of the Complaints dated 22.12.2024 and 23.12.2024, PS Subedari, Hanmakonda District, Telangana State forthwith and pass...”

2. Heard Sri Prabhakar Chikkudu, learned counsel for petitioner and the learned Government Pleader representing learned Advocate General appearing for respondents and Sri Takur Kiran Singh, learned counsel appearing for *detenu* Smt. Salaka Thumma.

3. When the matter is taken up for admission and hearing, learned Government Pleader has produced the

alleged *detenu* viz., Smt. Salaka before this Court and the *detenu* has informed this Court that she intends to stay with her parents.

4. In view of the submissions made by the *detenu*, this Court is of the view that the present petition cannot be entertained. However, liberty is given to the *detenue* viz., Smt. Salaka, who is a married women, to stay at her own place i.e., with her parents.

5. Accordingly, the Writ Petition is closed. No order as to costs.

6. As a sequel, miscellaneous applications pending if any, shall stand closed.
