KULDEEP TIWARI. J.(Oral)

1. Through the instant petition, prayer has been made by the petitioner for extension of parole granted by a co-ordinate Bench of this Court vide order dated 15.11.2023 (Annexure P-1), which is going to expire on 05.01.2024.

2. The instant relief has been sought on the ground that the petitioner had undergone a surgery, as he was diagnosed with gall bladder stone, and thereupon, Laparoscopic Cholecystectomy was done on dated 23.12.2023, and after getting recovered he was discharged on dated 25.12.2023.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has placed reliance on medical report dated 30.12.2023 (Annexure P-3), to show that the petitioner is suffering from weakness, and has been advised a complete rest for two weeks.

4. Notice of motion.

5. Mr. Karunesh Kaushal, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents-State and waives service.

6. This Court has examined the aforesaid medical certificate as issued by the doctor concerned, who operated upon the petitioner, and do not find any valid reason that the petitioner requires any medical intervention, as he is suffering from weakness only, from which he can otherwise recover in the jail itself.

7. Therefore, the instant prayer is declined and the petition is hereby **dismissed**, with a direction to the petitioner to re-step into the prison on dated 05.01.2024.

8. However, a direction is issued to the Superintendent of Jail concerned, that adequate medical aid, and proper diet be provided to the petitioner till he fully recovers from the weakness.

9. The Medical Officer posted in the jail concerned is also directed to conduct routine check up of the petitioner and provide all required medical aid to him.
