Having gone through the petition, it is evident that the marriage certificate dated 01.01.2024 has been issued by Deepak Sharma, Pandit, who is running a temple in the name of Pracheen Pashupati Nath Shiv Mandir Society at Booth No.228, M.D.C., Sector 4 Panchkula, but the petitioners have not arrayed the police authorities of State of Haryana or District Panchkula rather went on to implead the Commissioner of Police, District Jalandhar alongwith SHO, Police Station Rama Mandi, District Jalandhar, Punjab.

On this account itself, wherein the veracity of photographs is itself doubtful to establish that a valid Hindu marriage has taken place, this petition needs to be dismissed, wherein neither the proper and necessary parties have been arrayed nor satisfactory material has been placed on record to establish that marriage was solemnized as per Section 5 of Hindu Marriage Act, 1955.

After having heard the order pronounced in the open Court, learned counsel for the petitioners prays for withdrawal of the instant petition with liberty to file a fresh with better particulars.

In the larger interest of justice, prayer is accepted.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.
