HARKESH MANUJA, J. (Oral)

1. By way of present petition filed under Sections 10 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, prayer has been made for initiation of contempt proceedings against the respondents on account of alleged willful non-compliance of order dated 01.04.2019 passed by this Court in CWP-28657-2013.
2. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that the needful has been done and the arrears if any, shall be released in favour of petitioner within a period of 4 weeks.
3. In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press the present petition.
4. Dismissed as not pressed.
5. However, in case the needful is not done within the aforementioned period, as per the undertaking, the petitioner would be at liberty to seek revival of the contempt petition and in that eventuality, the erring/concerned Officer would be liable to pay additional sum of Rs.50,000/- as costs from his/her own pocket in favour of the petitioner towards litigation expenses, immediately, i.e. on the first date of listing of revival application.
