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DEEPAK GUPTA, J. (ORAL)

In compliance of the previous order dated 17.11.2023, learned counsel for the petitioner has produced a Demand Draft bearing No.899070 dated 25.01.2024 for an amount of ₹3,02,274/-, favoring Registrar Punjab & Haryana High Court drawn on Punjab National Bank. The said Demand Draft is directed to be deposited with the registry, which is further directed to convert it in a FDR in any nationalized bank so that, to whom it is ultimately paid, does not loose the interest. It shall be paid subject to the outcome of the litigation.

2. On instructions from ASI Gurdial Singh, it is also informed by learned State counsel that petitioner has already joined the investigation and after conclusion of the investigation, even challan has already been filed.

3. In view of the aforesaid facts and circumstances, the present petition is hereby accepted. Petitioner is allowed anticipatory bail in case FIR No.151 dated 29.10.2022 registered under Sections 420, 120-B of the IPC registered at Police Station Cantt Bathinda, District Bathinda.
4. It is directed that in the event of arrest of the petitioner, the petitioner shall be released on bail subject to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer/Investigating Officer. However, it is directed that the petitioner shall not contact any person associated with the case to influence him during trial in any manner whatsoever and shall not leave the country without prior permission of the Court. He shall further comply with the conditions stipulated in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
