The prayer in the petition under Section 438 Cr.PC is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.652 dated 23.11.2023 under Sections 406, 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B IPC registered at Police Station Pinjore, District Panchkula.

The learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners have joined investigation in terms of orders dated 05.01.2024 and were present before the Tehsildar concerned to execute the sale deed but the complainant did not come forward with the remaining amount under the agreement to sell.

The learned State counsel on instructions submits that the petitioners have joined investigation in terms of orders dated 05.01.2024 and are not required for custodial interrogation.

In this view of the matter, interim order dated 05.01.2024 is made absolute.

However, the petitioners shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and they shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
