The jurisdiction of this Court has been invoked under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus seeking direction to respondent No.2 to protect the lives and personal liberty of the petitioner and also to direct respondents No.3 to 6 not to interfere in the personal lives and liberty of the petitioner.

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that he will be satisfied in case a direction be issued to respondent No.2 to look into the representation dated 21.11.2023 (Annexure P-1), within a time bound manner.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Anmol Singh Sandhu, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State.

However, without advertng to the merits of the case as has been submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner as well, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Khanna, to look into the representation dated 21.11.2023 (Annexure P-1) and decide the same in accordance with law within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order.
