The prayer in the petition under Section 438 Cr.PC is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.238 dated 11.11.2022 registered under Sections 419, 420, 465, 468, 471, 201, 120-B IPC and Section 66-D of the Information Technology (Amendment) Act, 2008 registered at P.S. Kotwali, Patiala, District Patiala.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 08.01.2024 passed by this Court, petitioner has joined the investigation.

The learned State Counsel on instructions submits that the petitioner has joined investigation in terms of orders dated 08.01.2024 and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In this view of the matter, interim order dated 08.01.2024 is

made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
