1. The petitioner has filed the instant writ petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of directions to the respondents to circulate and pay all the retiral dues on account of service rendered by late Sh.Asha Nand, Junior Engineer, father of the petitioner, including pension for the period he remained alive.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that at present nothing survives in the present writ petition, therefore, he wishes to withdraw the same. He further submits that the respondents have passed recovery order against the petitioner, therefore, he may be granted liberty to challenge the same.
3. Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as aforesaid.
