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HARKESH MANUJA J. (Oral)

1. By way of present petition, prayer has been made for initiation of contempt proceedings against the respondents on account of alleged willful non-compliance of order dated 01.12.1998 passed by Presiding Officer, State School Tribunal, Punjab, Mini Secretariat, Chandigarh.
2. Learned State counsel, on instructions, submits that though the retiral benefits due to the petitioner have been released in favour of her legal representatives, however, interest @ 6% per annum on the delayed disbursement shall be released within a period of three weeks from today.
3. In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioner does not

want to press the present petition.

4. Dismissed as not pressed. Rule stands discharged.
5. However, in case the needful is not done within the  
aforementioned period, as per the undertaking, the petitioner would be at  
liberty to seek revival of contempt petition and in that eventuality, the  
erring/concerned officer would be liable to pay a sum of Rs.50,000/- as costs  
from his/her own pocket in favour of the petitioner towards litigation  
expenses, immediately, i.e. on the first date of listing of revival application.
