VIKAS BAHL, J.(ORAL)

1. On 27.02.1992, a Coordinate Bench of this Court had ordered that the present petition be heard alongwith RSA-1199-1990.

2. In RSA-1199-1990, this Court has been pleased to pass the following order:-

1. On 04.02.2020, none had appeared on behalf of the appellants and the registry was directed to issue fresh notice to the appellants as well as their counsel.

2. Again on 22.08.2023, none had appeared on behalf of the appellants and so was the position on 01.09.2023.

3. As per the report of the registry, appellant No. 1 as well as appellant Nos. 2 to 7 have died.

4. Learned counsel for the appellants has submitted that inspite of the best efforts, he has not been able to get in touch with the legal representatives of the appellants and hence, he prays that the present appeal may be dismissed for non-prosecution at this

stage but liberty may be granted to legal representatives of the appellants to revive the appeal in case any cause of action survives in the same.

5. *In view of the above facts and circumstances, present appeal is dismissed for non-prosecution at this stage with liberty to the legal representatives of the appellants to move an application for revival of the present case, in case, any cause of action survives in the same.*

6. *Pending miscellaneous application, if any, shall stand disposed of with the abovesaid order.”*

3. In the present case also, none has appeared on behalf of the petitioners nor anyone had appeared on behalf of the petitioners on 01.09.2023 and 22.08.2023.

4. Dismissed for non-prosecution. Liberty is granted to the petitioners to move an application for revival of the present revision petition in case, any cause survives.
