By way of present petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C., petitioner has prayed for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.70 dated 12.06.2022 registered under Sections 324, 34 IPC (offence under Section 307 IPC added later on vide DDR Annexure P.5 and offence under Section 323 IPC added in the challan) at Police Station Maur, District Bathinda.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the matter has already been compromised between the parties and copy of that compromise is dated 21.06.2022 (Annexure P.3). Learned counsel for the petitioner has also placed on record copy of the order dated 05.01.2024 passed in CRM-M-64348 of 2023 wherein co-accused Kushal Kumar @ Khushali has already been allowed bail by this Court.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Mohit Thakur, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent- State. Mr. Gagandeep Singh Simble, Advocate accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.2 and filed his Power of Attorney.

Learned counsel for respondent No.2 – complainant concedes the factum of compromise.

Having regard to the afore-said facts and circumstances stated above, particularly the compromise having been effected amongst the parties and on the basis of parity, the present petition is allowed. Petitioner is admitted to bail on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned trial Court/ Duty Magistrate concerned, on usual terms and conditions.
