1. This Contempt Petition has been filed under Section 10 of the Contempt of Court Act read with Section 151 CPC for taking action against the respondents for wilful disobedience of orders dated 08.07.2002 clarified vide orders dated 17.07.2002 and 26.11.2002 passed in CWP No.10064 of 2002 by a Division Bench of this Court.

2. On the last date of hearing i.e. 29.05.2024, learned counsel for the petitioner sought adjournment to get instructions from the petitioner as to whether any cause still survives or not. Learned counsel submits that despite his best efforts he is not able to get further instructions.

3. In view of the above, present petition is dismissed for non-prosecution. However, liberty is granted to the petitioner to get the petition revived in case any cause still survives.
