1. This is a contempt petition filed under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, for initiating contempt proceedings against the respondent for violating the order dated 16.08.2000 passed in CWP-6096-1997.

2. It is submitted by learned counsel for the respondent and is also so stated in the written statement filed by the respondent that the claim of the petitioners stands rejected. The specific order to that effect was also passed rejecting the claim of the petitioner because the petitioner had not choose the option w.e.f. 01.01.1988.

3. In view of the above, this is no ground to proceed further in the matter.

4. Dismissed.

5. However, if any grievance of the petitioners is left un-redressed, they would be at liberty to raise the same in any alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
