1. This is a contempt petition filed under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, for initiating contempt proceedings against the respondent for disobedience of the order dated 12.10.2022 passed in CWP-23376-2022.

2 Learned counsel for the respondent has submitted that in compliance of the order of the Writ Court, necessary speaking order dated 07.05.2024 has been passed by the respondent. Hence, the present petition has been rendered as infructuous.

3. Dismissed.

However, since learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner was not granted an opportunity of personal hearing, therefore, if any grievance of the petitioner is left un-redressed, he would be at liberty to avail any alternate remedy by challenging the speaking order passed by the respondent.
