SANDEEP MOUDGIL, J (ORAL)

1. The jurisdiction of this Court has been invoked under Section 482 Cr.P.C., seeking direction to respondent No.5 for getting done the postmortem of deceased wife of the petitioner by constituting the Board of Doctors and video recording of the said postmortem examination and thereafter the matter be conducted in fair and transparent manner.
2. Notice of motion.
3. Sh. Satya Pal Jain, ASG with Ms. Saigeeta Srivastava, Sr. Panel Counsel accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.1/UOI and Mr. H.S. Sitta, DAG Haryana accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.2 to 10.
4. Mr. H.S. Sitta, DAG Punjab on instructions from SI Balwinder Singh submits that State has no objection to get the postmortem of deceased wife of petitioner to be conducted by a Board of Doctors, which shall consist of Civil Surgeon, Civil Hospital, Fatehgarh Sahib, Medical Superintendent of the said Hospital; an expert from the Forensic Science Laboratory of the State and an

Officer from the Department of Health Services, Government of Punjab not below the rank of Deputy Director. It is also directed that the said postmortem shall be videographed and after conducting the same, the report be submitted to the Investigating Agency within one week thereafter.

5. The postmortem on the body of deceased shall be conducted tomorrow i.e., 06.01.2024, wherein the petitioner undertakes before this Court to co-operate and make necessary arrangements to take the body of deceased to Civil Hospital at 10 A.M.

6. In the light of aforesaid terms, the present petition stands disposed of.
