1. This is a contempt petition filed under Section 10 read with Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, for punishing the respondents for disobeying the order dated 29.07.2019 passed in CWP-20655-2019.
2. Compliance report by way of affidavit of Rakesh Kumar Krail, Chief Engineer/Headquarters & Dispute Resolution, Water Resources Department, Punjab, filed in the Registry, is taken on record.
3. Counsel for the respondents submits that the order dated 29.07.2019 passed in CWP-20655-2019 has been complied with and speaking order dated 21.07.2023 (Annexure R-1) has been passed.
4. Counsel for the petitioner has not even disputed the aforesaid fact.
5. In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.
6. However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left unredressed, he would be at liberty to raise the same in any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
