1. Learned State counsel has informed that all the prosecution witnesses already stand examined and the matter is at the stage of recording statements of defence witnesses and is fixed before the learned Trial Court on 26.04.2024.
2. In view of the aforesaid position, wherein this Court finds that the trial is at the fag end, this Court does not deem it appropriate to release the petitioner on bail and at this belated stage particularly when serious allegations of murder have been levelled against the petitioner. The present petition, as such, is disposed of with a direction to the learned Trial Court concerned to expedite the conclusion of trial.
3. Petition is disposed of accordingly.
