The prayer in the petition under Section 438 Cr.PC is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.182 dated 21.11.2023 registered under Sections 381 and 34 IPC P.S. A-Division, District Police Commissionerate, Amritsar Sahib.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 08.01.2024 passed by this Court, petitioner has joined the investigation.

The learned State Counsel has filed a short reply by way of affidavit of Mr. Gurinderbir Singh, PPS, Assistant Commissioner of Police, (East), Amritsar City in the Court today, which is taken on record and on instructions submits that the petitioner has joined investigation in terms of orders dated 08.01.2024 and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In this view of the matter, interim order dated 08.01.2024 is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and she shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
