1. Instant petition has been preferred under Section 482 Cr.PC for direction to the official respondents to conduct speedy and fair investigation and decide the representation dated 04.12.2023 (Annexure P-1) moved by the petitioner.

2. Heard.

3. It is, *inter alia*, contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that FIR No. 55 dated 04.03.2022 under Sections 325/323/34 IPC (Annexure P-3) was registered against the petitioner. He further contends that no action had been taken on the MLR dated 11.02.2022 (Annexure P-2) produced by the petitioner whereby the petitioner himself had sustained injuries and in this regard, he had moved a representation

dated 04.12.2023 (Annexure P-1), but no action has been taken on the said representation.

4. Notice of motion to the official respondents.
5. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Sarabjit Singh Cheema, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the State-respondents.
6. Considering the averments made in the petition, without commenting on the merits thereof, the petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No. 3 to consider the averments made in the representation dated 04.12.2023 (Annexure P-1), to dispose of the same expeditiously and to take action, as warranted, under the provisions of the law.
7. Decision so taken be conveyed to the petitioner.
