The present criminal writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking directions to the respondents to consider and grant parole to the petitioner for four weeks to meet his family and make arrangements for the marriage of his nephew (brother's son) and to be a part of the ceremonies in the marriage which starts from 02.02.2024 to 06.02.2024.

Learned counsel for the petitioner *inter alia* contends that the petitioner is the eldest sibling in the family and as such, his presence in the performance of the marriage ceremony of his nephew is very important even the name of the petitioner is mentioned in the invitation card. The petitioner has applied for parole by filing an application addressed to the Superintendent of Jail, District Jhajjar, however, no action has been taken on his prayer. Therefore, the petitioner is left with no other option but to approach this Court. He further relies upon the ratio of law laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in '*Asfaq Vs. State of Rajasthan*' (2017) 15 SCC 55.
