The petitioner, by way of present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C., prays for grant of pre-arrest bail in case bearing FIR No. 162 dated 07.11.2022, under Sections 436 & 427 of IPC, registered at Police Station Majitha Road, District Amritsar.

[2] Learned State Counsel, on instructions from the quarter concerned, submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation in terms of order dated 08.01.2024 and is not required for custodial interrogation.
