1. Instant petition under Section 482 Cr.PC has been preferred seeking directions to the official respondents No. 1 to 4 to look into the matter and take legal action against the private respondents No. 5 and 6 in case FIR (Annexure P-1) as under: -

2. Heard.

3. It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner got the aforesaid FIR registered against the private respondents on 18.09.2021 but no action has been taken on the said FIR. He further contends that the petitioner has even moved a representation dated

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17.11.2023 (Annexure P-2) before the Senior Superintendent of Police, District Pathankot, but no action has been taken thereon.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner further contends that the for the purpose of the present petition, the petitioner will be satisfied if appropriate directions are issued to respondent No. 3 to consider and dispose of the representation (Annexure P-2) in accordance with the law in an expeditious manner.

5. Notice of motion to the official respondents.

6. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Gurpreet Singh Sandhu, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents and on instructions, from ASI Ram Lal, Police Station Taragarh, District Pathankot, submits that the aforesaid representation shall be decided in an expeditious manner in accordance with law.

7. In the circumstances of the case and without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No. 3-Senior Superintendent of Police, District Pathankot, to consider the averments made in the representation dated 17.11.2023 (Annexure P-2), to dispose of the same expeditiously and to take action, as warranted, under the provisions of the law.

8. Decision so taken be conveyed to the petitioner.
