This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 11 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India for initiating contempt proceedings against the respondents for disobeying the order dated 18.03.2010 passed by this Court in CWP-6115-2008.

The perusal of the order dated 18.03.2010 qua which the contempt is asserted shows that the direction was issued to count the service of the petitioner in the aided institution for the purpose of grant of ACP/higher standard pay-scales. However, the petitioner has not disputed that the petitioner has not rendered any service in any aided institution. Moreover, learned counsel for the respondents has submitted that since the petitioner had not served in any aided institution, therefore, the respondents had rejected the claim of the petitioners by passing a speaking order dated 18.04.2023.

In view of the above, this Court does not find any ground to proceed further in the matter. Hence, the same is dismissed.

However, if any grievance of the petitioners is left un-addressed, they would be at liberty to raise the same in any alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
