Through the instant petition, the petitioner seeks quashing of the work allotted by the Municipal Corporation, Jalandhar (for short 'MC'), to M/s Darashaw and Company Private Limited, Mumbai, (for short 'the Company'), requiring the company to assist in the earmarking of street vending zones in the city of Jalandhar.

2. At the outset, learned counsel appearing for the MC informs us that the work had been approved to be allotted by the MC to the Company on 10.08.2018, and, thereafter, in terms of the work order, the Company submitted its report which was then forwarded by the MC to the State Government which accepted the said report resulting in the issuance by the Government a notification dated 01.06.2019, earmarking different street vending zones in the City of Jalandhar.



3. In the light of above factual position, which remains undisputed, it is clear that at this stage, no relief can be granted especially when the petitioners had approached this Court after over one year and three months from the date of grant of the work order to the company by the MC and because they have also not challenged the notification of the State dated 01.06.2019, which took to the logical end the work executed by the Company.

4. Dismissed.
