1. The present petition has been filed by the petitioner seeking grant of anticipatory bail in criminal case having FIR No. 355 dated 15.11.2023 registered at Police Station IMT, Rohtak, under Sections 153A and 153B of IPC.
2. Vide order dated 09.01.2024, the petitioner was granted interim bail with direction to join the investigation with the police.
3. Counsel for the petitioner apprised the Court that in compliance of the aforesaid order, the petitioner joined investigation with the police and even otherwise, the petitioner who is a lady aged about 54 years has been falsely implicated in the present case and in the other criminal cases also, wherein the petitioner has already been granted anticipatory bail by the

Court concerned.

4. The State counsel on instructions from SHO Dilbagh Singh, Police Station IMT, Rohtak submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation with the police, in compliance of the previous order and now the petitioner is not required for further investigation or custodial interrogation by the police in the present case.

5. In light of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and order of interim bail dated 09.01.2024 is made absolute. However, the petitioner is to abide by the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
