Through the instant petition, grievance has been raised by the petitioner, that he has been declared as proclaimed offender by the learned trial Court concerned, vide order dated 04.03.2023 (Annexure P-1), and has thrown a challenge to the same.

Learned counsel for the petitioner fails to point out any illegality or perversity in the order (supra). Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is ready and willing to join the proceedings before the learned trial Court concerned.

Without commenting on the merits of the case, or the illegality of the order passed by the learned trial Court concerned, this Court directs the petitioner to cause an appearance before the learned trial Court concerned, within 15 days. In case the petitioner causes appearance before the learned trial Court concerned, within 15 days, and move a proper application for grant of regular bail, the latter shall make every endeavor to decide the bail application, if any, moved, most expeditiously, preferably on the same day. Only till then the arrest of the petitioner

shall remain stayed.

In case the petitioner does not cause an appearance before the learned trial Court concerned, within 15 days, the interim protection granted by this Court shall be *ipso facto* vacated, without any further reference to this Court.

Disposed of accordingly.
