 This is a contempt petition filed under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India for initiating contempt proceedings against the respondent for disobeying the order dated 26.05.2023 passed in CWP-643-2022.

 Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the present petition has been rendered infructuous because the order has already been complied with by the respondent by passing a speaking order.

 Dismissed as having been rendered as infructuous.

 However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left un-redressed, he would be at liberty to raise the same in any alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
