1. This petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for direction to the respondents No. 1 to 3 for registration of FIR against respondents No. 4 and 5 for cheating and forgery of agreement to sell and converting and using blank documents got signed from petitioner and her husband into agreement to sell and other documents viz. valuable security etc. and taking appropriate action against respondents No. 4 and 5.

2. Mr. Bhriugu Dutt Sharma, Advocate has appeared on behalf of respondent No. 4 and filed his power of attorney which is taken on record.

3. At the outset, learned State counsel submits that the veracity of the allegation made by the petitioner has been thoroughly examined and it has been concluded that no police action is warranted and the complaint filed by the petitioner has been ordered to be consigned to record.

4. In view of the stand taken by the learned State counsel, learned

counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the present petition and seeks liberty of this Court to invoke his alternative remedy in accordance with law.

5. Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.
